SENIORS: If you are a senior taking COA classes (APEX and FLVS) in the SPRING semester, remember, Graduates with Highest Honors are computed at the first 9-weeks. Grades for graduation with honors, valedictorian, salutatorian, etc. will be calculated based on your COA course grades at the 9-week period in the Spring semester. You need to be up-to-date on all coursework at the 9-week grading period (March 12, 2021), otherwise, your class status may be negatively affected. Your GRADE TO DATE grade at the 9-weeks mark is used to compute Graduates with Honors. Remember, any missing assignments are averaged as zeros. Students in dual enrollment classes will need to get their 3rd 9 weeks grade on March 12th from their dual enrollment teachers to calculate who graduates with honors. The AP test order deadline is Friday, March 12.
